

Technical Information

General

- In mass start events, the riders shall enter the track from the home straight and leave the track from the back straight.
- Riders are forbidden to sit on the track surface.
- In final sessions, in all events, all riders, including winners, will have to exit the track on the back straight and go through the media mixed zone.
- Anybody failing to respect the instructions of the race organization or commissaires will be penalized by a fine of CHF 200-500 as per UCI Regulation 3.10.008-7.1.
- Anybody committing a second offense of incorrect behavior, will be fined CHF 500 and may have their accreditation immediately revoked.
- Only equipment to be used on the day can be located infield, others must be stored in team cabins

On board Technology

- On board technology equipment that has the ability and purpose to collect or transmit data, information or images is authorized. Conditions of utilizations are defined in art. 1.3.024ter and include:
 - Does not affect the bicycle certification (modification) / Non-removable during the race / Information not visible to the rider

Timed events

- For Team Sprint, the blue bands shall be made impassable at the start by the placing of three 50 cm long pads of a synthetic material every 5 meters from the pursuit line.

Team Sprint

- The qualification heats will be run one team at a time on the track.
- For Team Sprint, the blue bands shall be made impassable by the placing of three 50 cm long pads of a synthetic material every 5 meters from the pursuit line.

Sprint & 200-meter Time Trial

- Riders shall wear both number panels during the 200 meters Time Trial.
- Phase of competition:
 - Men Elite – first 3 in 200m qualifying will advance straight to semi finals, the last 2 will race for the 4th position.
 - Women Elite and Junior – Best 4 will advance to semi finals
 - Men Junior – the fastest rider will advance straight to semi finals, the other to quarter finals

Elimination

- During the start, holders are allowed to push their riders, but are not allowed to move from their places in order to avoid crashes at the start.
- If no decision can be made about which rider to eliminate, then no riders shall be eliminated until the next sprint. This shall be indicated by a green flag on the start line.
- An eliminated rider shall leave the track immediately, failing which he may be disqualified from the entire

Omnium event

- Coaches or Managers who instruct or encourage their rider to continue racing following the announcement of their elimination, will be penalized by a fine of CHF 500 as per UCI Regulation 3.10.008-6.3. Subject to the same penalties, no team representative can approach or try to dispute any decision made by Commissaires during the course of the race.
- In the case of a mishap in the Elimination, the neutralization will be of 5 laps maximum. The race could however be restarted before the 5 laps of neutralization if all concerned riders are back in the race.
- Race Distance
 - Men Elite – Scratch 10km, Tempo 10km, Points Race 24km
 - Women Elite – Scratch 5km, Tempo 5km, Points Race 8km
 - Men Junior – Scratch 7.5km, Tempo 7.5km, Points Race 8km
 - Women Junior – Scratch 5km, Tempo 5km, Points Race 8km

Points Race

- Race Distance
 - Men Elite – 30km, 90 laps, 15 sprints
 - Women Elite – 10km, 30 laps, 5 sprints
 - Men Junior – 20km, 60 laps, 10 sprints
 - Women Junior – 8km, 24 laps, 4 sprints

Scratch Race

- Race Distance
 - Men Elite – 15km
 - Women Elite – 10km
 - Men Junior – 10km
 - Women Junior – 7.5km
